It was a nod to the unique set of personalities that starred in its weeknight programming and it was catchy – and true. It's always good to have a few characters in your life. Some of those characters are just so quirky that you can't forget them. One of my youth ministry helpers in California, Keith, was big into antique cars and had a full-time job as a photographer (weddings, family events, etc.), but while he was a little nerdy, he was great with kids that were on the periphery of



our junior high group. And he was highly dependable.

Darrell was a farmer I met in Illinois. He had an 'edge' to him, so he was wasn't a guy to be trifled with, but he was really smart, he was a doting grandfather to

three kids at our church, and he was great at hiring high school kids as summer help on his land, keeping teens out of trouble and offering them a healthy paycheck while dispensing practical advice and Cokes during breaks.

Betty was one with a bit of an edge too, but she had been a single mother nearly all her adult life and she needed it to raise her family. She attended our church, cooked for a local senior center, and was a faithful ladies' Bible Study member on Wednesdays.

I met Bill in Ohio. He was a longtime basketball

coach, quick with a funny story but always willing to lend some helpful wisdom in a

pinch. Mary was in that same church too, a lady I got to know when I officiated her husband's funeral. She was a kind-hearted sort, very resourceful, and jerry-rigged a special chair with a string on it that she kept in her truck so she could get in and out more easily, since she was short.

In Iowa, there was Don, a guy who worked for the city's parks department and dabbled as an auctioneer, a rough-around-the-edges guy with a soft heart and a ready smile. He allowed me into his life as he faced down cancer and I'd visit him while he took chemo infusions.

Alberta was a sweet woman, had a special-needs adult son that she doted upon, and our common interest was bowling.

Of course, there are plenty of characters here in Stromsburg, NE; people you can visit at the coffee shop, sit in the stands by at Cross County High sporting events, or see out and about in town. And there are plenty of Bible characters too, which led me to considering a series I'll call "Characters Welcome" over the next 12 weeks following Easter. Some are tales of great people you've probably heard of already from scripture. A few are more obscure or maybe you've perceived them in one way and I'll tell about them a bit differently. Two represent people who have lessons to share. Two are characters in one Old Testament book, one a story to aspire to, the other a character trait to avoid. We trust that God will have something to teach us through these interesting characters.
