"Transitions"

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid: do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9

Change can be scary. It seems, especially in this world of constant change, that you just get used to doing things one way and then something out of your control changes how you were doing it. This is true in society at large and also in the church. It can be uncomfortable.

God is doing something new here at Stromsburg Covenant. If you were part of the semi-annual meeting on July 24 you heard about the pastoral reconfiguring we are going to be experiencing going forward.

For a long time Craig and I (and others that know him and have observed his ministerial gifts) have felt that God was calling him into ministry to seniors either through retirement home chaplaincy or hospice chaplaincy. In the past year Craig has been looking for a part-time hospice chaplaincy that would enable him to dip his feet into that ministry while still following his call to ministry here at Stromsburg Covenant. We were thinking future.

He had been in contact with Aaron Phillips, who is the director of Hospice for Aseracare in York, to just keep his ears open for any per diem hospice chaplaincy jobs nearby.

In June he ran into Aaron at the concession stand at a Burg ball game and Aaron told him that their current full-time hospice chaplain had given notice and they were going to be hiring someone. His comment was "I think this is providential." We did too and felt Craig needed to apply—to see if this was a door God was opening. Within a week he was offered the position. At this time we were leaving for the Annual Gathering for the Covenant at the end of June and we decided to spend that time away seeking God and seeking wise counsel from others in ministry to see if this was where God was leading us.

The Annual Gathering was what we needed to listen for God's voice and his will for not only us but for youour church. I sensed a renewing of my call as a pastor to you—to be more than the worship planner. organizer, office manager and occasional preacher that I am now. I'm still not completely sure what that means but God has been showing me little by little. (He knows that if he put it all out there in front of me all at once I'd be tempted to run away.)

"Courage, dear heart." It's a quote from Aslan, the lion in the CS Lewis Narnia Chronicles. He's my favorite fictional character of all time because he is a picture of Jesus to me. He is telling Lucy Pevensy to have courage to do the hard things, the seeming impossible things—even though she's just a little girl because he is with her. I have a pendant of a lion with this quote on it hanging around my neck most of the time—just to remind me to find my strength and courage in Jesus-the Lion of Judah-and not to try to come up with it myself.

We decided that Craig would accept the Hospice Chaplaincy call and begin August 1. I decided that instead of running away I would rush headlong into whatever God was calling me to do for you—his church.

When we came back from the Annual Gathering we met right away with Dennis Nuttelman and Ryan Cooper—our chair and vice-chair, to hash out what this might mean for us going forward.

This is what we came up with and then we sought and were granted the lead team's approval. Then we brought it to the congregation last week and were overwhelmed with your approval and support.

For the next six months Pastor Craig will continue to be our visitation pastor and preach once a month. Pastor Mary will continue to be the administrative and worship pastor and will preach twice a month. Ryan

Cooper has agreed to preach once a month and continue his valuable leadership in our worship arts ministries. During this six months we will be evaluating how things are going—what seems to be working and what doesn't.
