A Word From the Pastor

Since we have had two leadership-related exercises in the past week, we decided to wait until after our in-house retreat on February 2nd to get our newsletter out this month. We're grateful to Brent Thompson from the Midwest Conference office for visiting and getting us thinking about how we can best use our corporate gifts to further our ministry in the community and beyond. His sermon on Acts 6 was helpful and practical and the discussion over lunch was thoughtful and clarified a few things that the results of a values survey we'd asked people to fill out had brought to the surface.

In general, three things stood out from our leadership discussion on February 2nd: (1) we've begun to regroup as a congregation after the inherent flux of having changing pastors four times within a span of eight years; (2) our communication within the church – while better – is still a work in progress, particularly within leadership teams or ministry teams: and, (3) we're tired and trying to grapple with the normal ministry rhythm of a small church and the reality that we may have to pare things down some.

As pastors, it's good to have honest discussion, even if it may not have been all warm fuzzies. People are allowed to be tired after having given great effort in various ministries to offset the loss of parishioners over the past half dozen years. People are allowed to grieve the loss of something they miss (friends, a ministry no longer sustainable). People are allowed to wonder out loud how we can grow when we're not seeing younger families flocking to our doors on a Sunday (especially if they're nice about it). I mentioned in our meeting that "it's okay to say no to a task" if you're not invested or have the energy to meet the need and I mean it. God isn't calling us to obligatory tasks, usually, but to Spirit-discerned ministry opportunities that more often than not are in our gifts set.

I told the story about Paxton Covenant Church in central Illinois as my story of hope as we considered our future and it's worth repeating. In the summer of 2008, I (Craig) accepted a call to pastor a church with 65 in average Sunday worship attendance, but 29 of 100 in its total demographic that were over the age of (I believe) 75...and we had few regular attenders that had grade-school kids. Still, in year two, we re-started a Wednesday night kids program they'd done after school and I know my CE board wasn't optimistic about it. But 15 months after it began, we had around 20 (age 4 through grade 5) coming, a majority outside our congregation. And during a five-week period around Christmas, a handful of families invited five specific families they knew to our Sunday services. All five families stayed around for at least two years – 10 adults, 13 children.

By the time our family had moved on to a church in Ohio, there were only 9 of the 29 people 75-and-over still part of our church. But the worship attendance was over 70 and the intergenerational look on a Sunday was healthy and continues to be, based on what we've been told by a few families we're still in regular contact with.

In Mason City, Iowa, Pastor Mary and I were associate pastors

over about four years, prior to our move to Illinois. When we arrived, there was ONE couple that was between the ages of 25-35. But that couple's faithfulness was rewarded and when we left that congregation, the K through 5th grade children's program had grown from 4 to more than 40 as the church had used an Alpha program and had taken a risk and started a contemporary worship service where drinking coffee in the sanctuary was deemed acceptable (if you put a lid on the cups). Young families had been attracted to those ministries.

There's no reason to think that either scenario is impossible here. We received 26 value audit surveys in the past nine days (ranking each value word from 1 to 4, with 4 being most important to you. The things you seem to value most are: (1a) Worship, (1b) Prayer, (1c) Community, (2) Bible Knowledge, (3a) Encouragement, and (3b) Lost People. These are good things to aspire to corporately, and our task as leaders is to flesh out what they mean for us as a Body and how they'll translate to better ministry TOGETHER in our corner of the world.

In the meantime, let's worship together, pray with a united spirit, and aim to be encouraging to each other as we discern next steps, knowing that "He will deliver a harvest if we do not give up."
