# A Word From the Pastor

A year ago, during a four-month stay in Texas, the pastor at the church we attended engaged his congregation in a Route 66 sermon series which comprised one sermon on every book in the Bible. I thought to myself, "Wow, what a great idea," knowing that a number of books hardly get any play when a pastor puts together a preaching schedule. And, of course, the whole intrigue about driving Route 66 HAD to be part of the genius of this title.

But for the Pinley family, Route 81 seems to be the intriguing highway, since nearly half of our mileage on trips to see family in Texas occurs on that pleasant thoroughfare. And, as it turned out, we listened to the back end of the Old Testament during the Route 66 series and the sermons on the minor prophets were interesting. And so an idea was planted...

Following a sermon January 5<sup>th</sup> to remember Epiphany as our official end to Advent, we'll begin our Route 81 series, using 8 sermons from Old Testament prophets and 1 from a prophet in the New Testament. Each sermon will examine something that we can KNOW from each prophet/ prophetic word. It'll go as follows:

-January 12<sup>th</sup>: **Ezekiel** (particularly 1:28 – 3:11) - *"Know What Feeds You."* 

-January 19: Jonah - *"Know your Ninevah"...*church planter Cath Kaminski will also give testimony about a new congregation, Beacon Covenant, in the Lincoln area

-January 26: Micah - "Know what God requires"...this is also the day of our Annual Business meeting

-February 2: Guest speaker Brent Thompson of the Midwest Conference – Leadership...with session for our leaders after church

-February 9: Nahum - "Know the Truth"

-February 16: Habakkuk - "Know your Bias"

-February 23: **Zephaniah** - *"Know Who Is Behind You"*
