A Word From Pastor Craig

It's been a hectic and thought-provoking month for the Pinley family, but as we've been processing the passing of Pastor Mary's mother, OraLee Kirkham, our first thoughts are of gratefulness to you for your care prior to and after her passing. I don't think you can ever fully prepare for a loved one's passing or have a set timetable, so the suddenness of her demise brought a hectic pace to things. Your willingness to handle some key details and your generosity and flexibility were amazing. Thanks so much.

The other process that occurs when someone dies is to review the stories of their life. The week we spent in Jacksonville, TX, allowed for some of that process, as family members shared stories of OraLee Kirkham from their own perspective – and for me (Pastor Craig), it offered some new insights into who she was and what she meant to others over the decades.

When we read the Bible, we sometimes forget that the 66-book set represents the story of the people of God. We may compartmentalize pieces of scripture (Israel's start, wisdom literature, prophetic word, life of Jesus, the early church, Letters to the Church) and not keep it as a whole. But as we begin, the story of Genesis provides a great deal to this early account. So with that in mind, I thought it appropriate to preach this fall on the book of Genesis, which will begin September 21, coinciding with our Fall Sunday School kickoff. I'll preach on various parts of Genesis, in the following order: Sept. 20 – Genesis series: Part One - "God the Creator and Order Maker" (Gen. 1:1 thru 2:3)
Sept. 27 – Genesis series: Part Two – "The Ones

- that Started it All" (Adam and Eve, Gen. 3:1-24)
- Oct. 4 Genesis series: Part Three "The Children of the Sin" (Cain and Abel, Gen. 4:1-16)
- Oct. 11 Genesis series: Part Four "When God Grieved over Humankind" (Noah, Gen. 6:5-22)
- Oct. 18 Genesis series: Part Five "The Man Who Went...And Trusted" (Abraham, Gen. 12:1-9)
- Oct. 25 Genesis series: Part Six "The Girl Who Laughed at God" (Sarah, Gen. 12:10-20; Gen. 18:1-15)
- Nov. 1 Genesis series (Pastor Mary) Part Eight: The Twin Who Walked to Heaven" (Jacob, Gen. 32)
- Nov. 8 Genesis series: Part Nine "The Boy Who Would Be Dreaming" (Joseph, Gen. 37:1-28)
- Nov. 15 Genesis series: Part Ten "The Boy Who Would Be Working" (Joseph, Gen. 39:1-23)
- Nov. 22 Genesis series: Part Eleven "The Man Who Would Be Forgiving" (Joseph, Gen. 45:3-20)

Following our journey through Genesis, I'll preach out of Advent texts on November 29 and December 6, with a church Christmas program tentatively scheduled for December 13^{th.} On December 20th, we'll enjoy a pre-Christmas worship service, with a guest preacher likely on tap for the December 27th worship service.
