#### Fall Series from Pastor Craig

When I was a sports writer, I enjoyed going to high school or college games over the course of a school year, but – by and large – the contests I wrote about were a hodgepodge of teams that I might cover once or twice per season. But in the winter of 1995, I covered the vast majority of games for a girls' basketball program that eventually won a state title. Christian High School in El Cajon, CA won 109 of 125 games over a four-year span, including two state championships. And one girl, Stephanie Shadwell, was a varsity player for all four years, eventually earning Player of the Year honors in San Diego County.

Stephanie ended her prep career about as spectacularly as you could; she drained a 40-foot shot at the buzzer as her Patriots beat Ripon Christian for the state's Division IV crown at Oakland Coliseum. And as the beat writer for the newspaper I worked for, I witnessed every game of her team's playoff run and perhaps half of the other contests her team competed in. I kept all of my material on that team from that season because it was such a unique and amazing experience from a team that eventually had four players play Division I sports.

The gospel of John resonates with me because of my writing experience over 25 years ago. The author of the gospel was the pseudo-"beat writer" of a ministry team for Jesus, 12 disciples that traveled regularly with the Lord over some three years, along with a larger contingent who was often around and did plenty of ministry themselves. John isn't the only disciple who wrote a gospel – so did Matthew – but it's clear that John was in the close circle of friends Jesus trusted. And I don't think it's an accident that John called himself, "the one that Jesus loved" in one of the last stories he told about the savior before Jesus left the earth 40 days following his resurrection from the dead.

I've chosen to preach 11 times this fall from the gospel of John, focusing on the ministry of Jesus up until the week prior to his death (stories about him during Holy Week and after his resurrection would be told during the Lenten season of the church year). And the birth account of Jesus isn't mentioned in John.

If you want to read ahead, the sermon texts are as follows:

- ♦ Sept. 12 John 1:19-34 (John the Baptist telling about the coming Messiah)
- ♦ Sept. 19 John 1:43-51 (A doubter and an optimist as disciples are called to serve)
- ♦ Sept. 26 John 2:1-12 (The first recorded miracle story of Jesus)
- ♦ Oct. 3 John 3:1-21 (Midnight visits and second births)
- ♦ Oct. 10 John 4:1-26; 39-42 (Discovering water that would keep one from ever thirsting again)
- ♦ Oct. 17 John 4:43-53 (Taking Jesus at his word)
- ♦ Oct. 24 John 6:16-40 (A bread that's tough to swallow)
- ♦ Oct. 31 John 8:1-11 (Jesus sending the critics away)
- ♦ Nov. 7 John 9:1-12 (What does it really mean to have sight or to be blind?)
- ♦ Nov. 14 John 10:19-42 (Who is Jesus Really?)
- ♦ Nov. 21 John 11:1-15; 38-43 (Resurrecting hope through a stinky dead guy)

The first Sunday in Advent occurs on November 28<sup>th</sup> and we'll preach more traditional Christmas season texts on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 19<sup>th</sup>. Our 7 p.m. Christmas Eve service is on Friday, December 24<sup>th</sup>. In Christ,
